

Research project – Traian TOMENCO

“YOUNG RESEARCHER” PROGRAMME

“Young Researcher” programme is a project of the Government of Romania which aims to support the young high school graduates which became 1st year students and which had excellent results during high school studies (1st, 2nd, 3rd prize/gold, silver, bronze medals or other equivalent prizes obtained at international olympics or other international competitions of innovations) in order to prepare them in a Romanian university for developing a career in science and research.

The scholarship attributed in April 2014 to Traian Tomenco supports a research project in the domain of constitutional law. The research project during the academic year 2014-2015 focused on the relationship between constitutional review and legal scholarship as well as on interdependencies between the two of them. For the academic year 2015-2016 the research will concentrate upon the constitutional features of specific administrative agencies in Romania within the broader EU context. The project is yet open to other research topics in the area of the constitutional law.

Winner of an international prize in the Olympics of geography and student at the Faculty of Law of the Bucharest University since 2013, Traian Tomenco is the recipient of a “Young Researcher” scholarship offered by the Romanian Government to meritorious students. Apart from pursuing his undergraduate studies Traian Tomenco also deploys an intensive activity as volunteer.
